

PROHIBITED ITEMS



Before your possessions are packed and loaded, it is important that you understand which items cannot be shipped.

Listed below are some common items that are non-allowables because they represent a hazard or are perishable. Hazardous materials are items that are flammable, corrosive or explosive.

HAZARDOUS MATERIALS

Examples include:

- Aerosol Cans
- Ammonia
- Ammunition
- Car Batteries
- Charcoal/Lighter Fluid
- Chemistry Sets
- Cleaning Solvents
- Darkroom Chemicals
- Fertilizer
- Fireworks
- Fuels/Oils
- Household Batteries
- Kerosene
- Liquid Bleach
- Loaded Guns
- Matches
- Nail Polish
- Nail Polish Remover
- Paint Thinners
- Paints/Varnishes
- Pesticides
- Poisons
- Pool Chemicals
- Propane Tanks
- Sterno
- Weed Killer

Perishables include foods, plants or living things that may die or spoil in transit. For shipments moving less than 150 miles and delivered within 24 hours of pickup, carriers may agree to transport perishables that are properly packed and require no servicing in transit.

You will need to address these items prior to your pack and load dates. Please take any items of extreme sentimental value with you.

PERISHABLES

Examples include:

- Frozen Food
- Open or Half-Used Foods
- Plants
- Produce
- Refrigerated Foods

Note: You should empty your refrigerator and freezer and allow appliance to dry out 24 hours before the move to prevent the growth of mold.
